Entrance fee: Area under the tower is free

Cost to go up: €11.30 to €36.10, depending on the level and whether you take the stairs or the elevator

**Duration:** About 2.5 hours

☐ **Louvre Museum** – Home to the Mona Lisa, Venus de Milo, and countless other masterpieces.

**Entrance fee: €22** 

**Duration:** Around 4-6 hours

□ **Notre-Dame Cathedral** – Admire the gothic beauty of this iconic cathedral, recently reopened.

**Entrance fee: €0** 

**Duration:** About 1 to 1.5 hours

☐ Arc de Triomphe – Climb to the top for breathtaking views of Paris, including Champs-

Élysées.

**Entrance fee: €16** 

**Duration:** Around 1.5 hours

□ Sacré-Cœur Basilica – Visit this famous white basilica atop Montmartre Hill. It's one of the

most visited and iconic sites in Paris.

Entrance fee: €0 Climb the tower: €8 Duration: About 1 hour

☐ **Musée d'Orsay** – Visit the former train station turned museum to see Impressionist masterpieces.

Entrance fee: €16 Duration: About 4 hours

☐ **Musée de l'Orangerie** – Home to Monet's Water Lilies and other stunning works of art.

Entrance fee: €12.50

Duration: About 2.5 hours

☐ <b>Disneyland Paris</b> – Take a day trip to Disneyland for magic and family fun.

Entrance fee: from 57 € Duration: Full day

- Keep in mind that service in cafes and restaurants is slow—it's not customary to rush waiters.
